


The questionnaire referred to parents/guardians of students who participated in the Erasmus program:

#### "Think globally, act locally! Let's live greener!"


It was anonymous and included seven multiple choice questions and one short answer question.




# 2. Was the communication with the accompanying teachers during the trip satisfying?






#### 3. Did the mobility program meet your child's expectations?


# 4. You think that your child's cooperation with the other students in the program was:




## 5. Did participation in the mobility program improve your child's ability to communicate in English?
