

"Creativity learning, entrepreneurship, and technology at the service of those who need it most"


It was anonymous and included seven multiple choice questions and one short answer question.


The answers used in the evaluation of the program.



1. Were you satisfied with the way the team was organized before the school's visits abroad?


2. Was the communication with the accompanying teachers during the trip satisfying?






3. Did the mobility program meet your child's expectations?


4. You think that your child's cooperation with the other students in the program was:




5. Did participation in the mobility program improve your child's ability to communicate in English?
